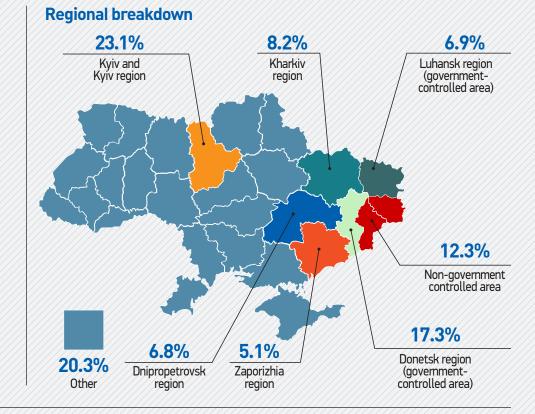

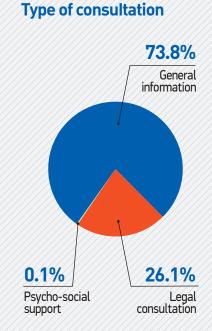
The DONBAS SOS Hotline has been supported by IOM since March 2015 for the purpose of providing impartial, comprehensive, and up-to-date information for IDPs. Since then it has received a total of **68,316** calls.
