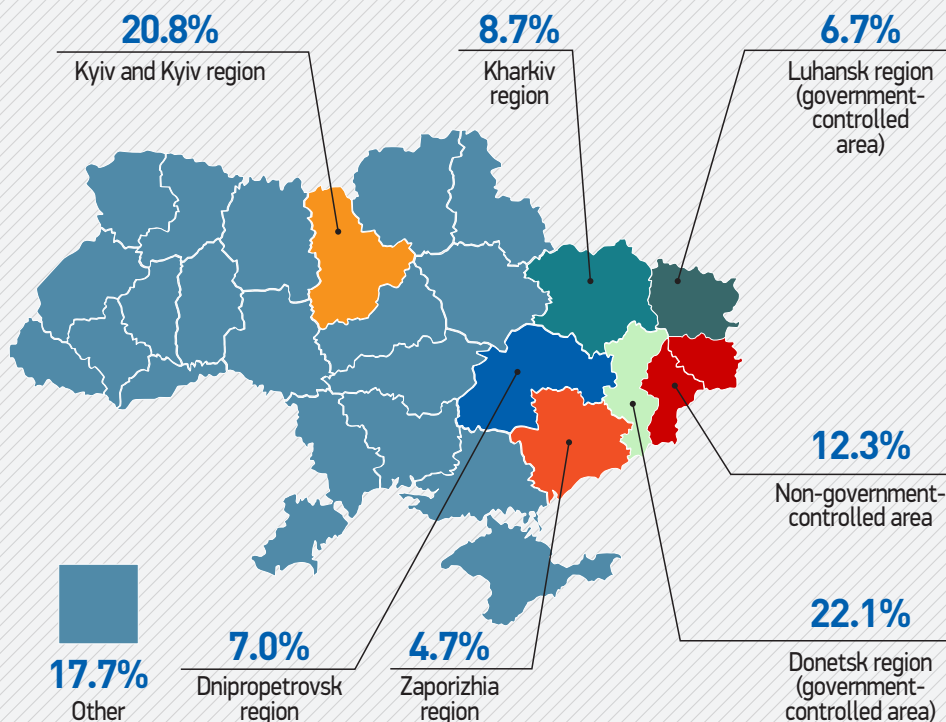

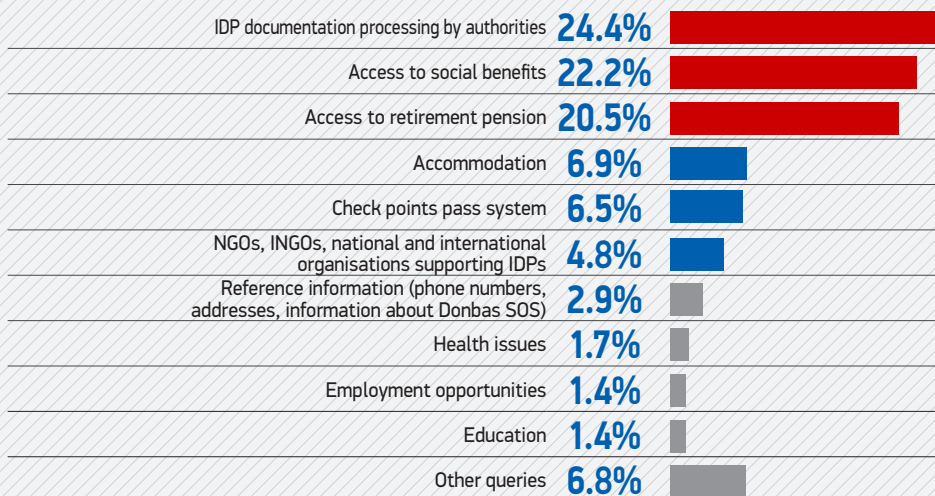

Regional breakdown



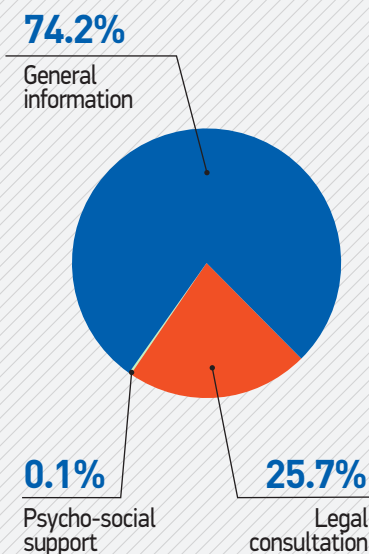

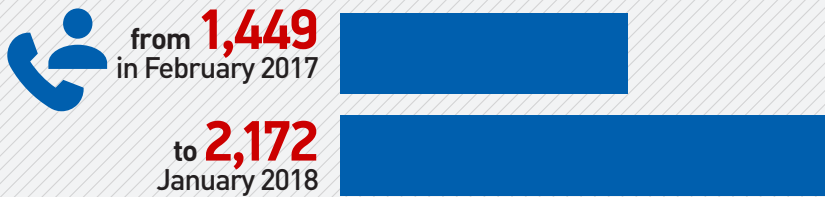

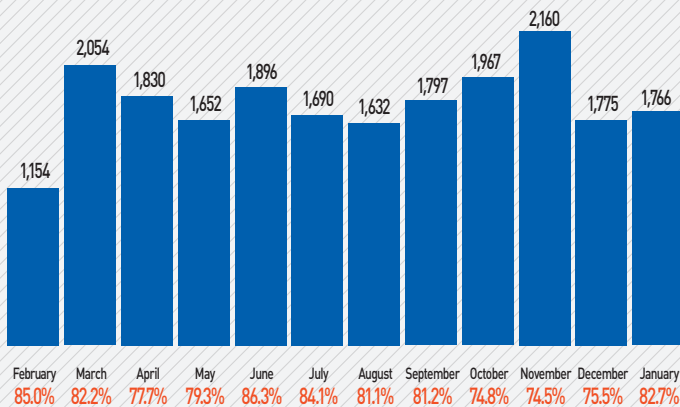

The total number of calls consistently increased

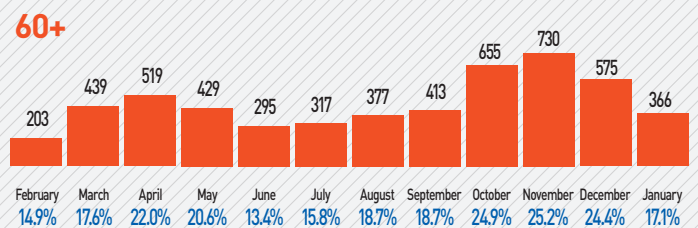


The number of calls from persons aged 60 years or over reached its highest in October, November, and December 2017, with the lowest – in February 2017.

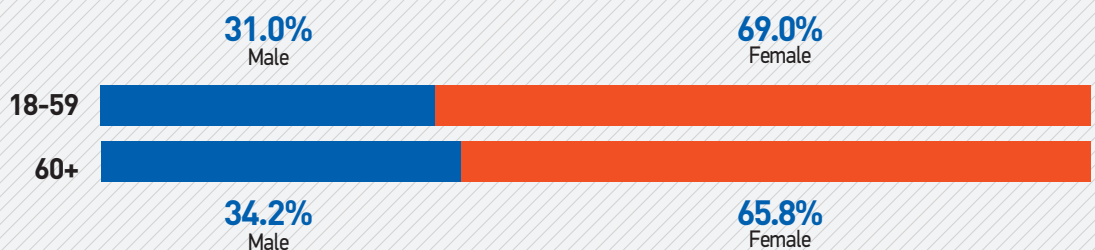

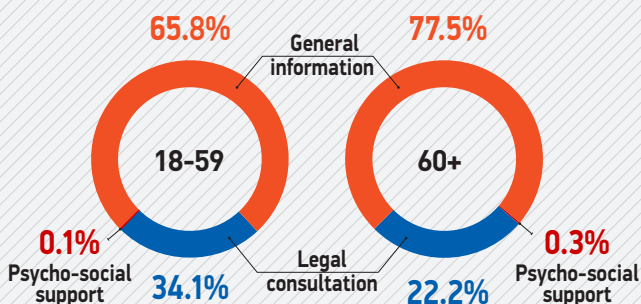
Total number of calls from age groups 18 - 59 and 60+ since February 2017
